General Conditions of the test - the small print. Please read carefully.

- This test, organised by Rare Management on behalf of SIGB, is accessible to retailers and the media involved in skiing and their nominated testers.
- It is the responsibility of all participating companies and organisations to ensure that their nominated testers:
 - are covered by appropriate winter sports insurance, including off-piste (if planning to ski off-piste) and have appropriate public liability cover
 - are competent to make subjective judgement and comment on the equipment that is being made available
 - are aware of their own DIN settings and how bindings should be adjusted on any equipment that they borrow
 - submit the appropriate portion of the test results card, or enter test reports via the Test App, for inclusion in the central results database
 - make every effort to avoid damage to test equipment
 - return test equipment as and when requested
 - ski under control and do not endanger other slope users
 - carry an avalanche transceiver, shovel and probe if skiing off-piste. And know how to use the equipment.
- As soon as any tester leaves the test centre area, it is on the basis that he/she is satisfied with both the adjustment and settings of the equipment to be tested. All testers acknowledge that the SIGB, their appointed organisers and the participating equipment suppliers cannot be held liable for any injuries that might occur during the period of the test.
- All equipment is made available by participating suppliers on the basis that it is supplied on loan and remains their property at all times.
- In order to take a pair of skis to test, the tester must leave with the supplier his or her test accreditation card, if requested. This will be returned when the skis are returned.
- SIGB and Rare Management reserve the right to refuse registration, or remove access to test skis, at their discretion.

Skier Level.

This self assessment should accurately reflect the ability level of each tester. This will remain confidential but will be used in analysing average results for skis to enable comparison of results by ability of tester. We will be using the following simplified levels:

- [C] Competitor** - Expert with experience in competitive racing, freeride etc.
- [E] Expert** - Able to ski all conditions and terrain at speed and in control.
- [A] Advanced** - Comfortable & accomplished on most slopes and types of snow but not completely happy with technique in certain conditions ie. ice, moguls, crud etc.
- [I] Intermediate** - Able to cruise the mountain but aware of problems carving properly and intimidated by black runs and difficult snow conditions.
- [L] Lower intermediate** - Cautious, stemming and skidding turns. Stick to blue, green or occasional red runs.
